Standard Crimp Terminals Used In The Mobile Electronics Industry




Crimp Terminals Are Manufactured In Three Different Options:

No Insulation: use these when soldering connections. You can either solder directly to non-insulated connectors or crimp the wire in place and finish with solder.



Vinyl Insulation: the most economical insulation for general purpose use.

Nylon Insulation: better mechanical properties than vinyl but higher in cost.



Industry Color Codes For Insulation:

Red: 18-22 guage wires
Blue: 14-16 guage wires
Yellow: 10-12 guage wires
